



Dinosaurs Revealed Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What dates and hours are the museum and this temporary feature exhibit open?

Q. How much does it cost to attend the exhibit? Where can I purchase tickets?

A. Due to limited capacity and high demand, we strongly encourage guests to purchase tickets to *Dinosaurs Revealed* in advance on [our Ticketing page](#), or via phone at 503.797.4000.

Q. How long does it take to see the exhibit?

A. Individual visit times will vary, but most guests can anticipate spending 60 to 90 minutes viewing *Dinosaurs Revealed*. There is no time limit within the exhibit, and guests may enjoy it for as long as the museum is open.

Q. Is photography permitted in the exhibit?

A. Absolutely! Guests are encouraged to take photos so they can share with their friends and family (be sure to tag the museum: @omsi and #omsi). Guests should respect the privacy of others and not use flash, so as not to distract from the exhibit experience.

Q. Are food and drink permitted in the exhibit?

A. Food or drink are not permitted in the featured exhibit hall.

Q. Can I bring my stroller into the exhibit if I have young children with me?

A. Yes. Strollers are permitted inside the exhibit.

Q. What COVID-19 related measures is OMSI taking to ensure everyone's health and safety?

A. We have taken several measures to prioritize everyone's health and safety:

- Exhibit admissions are currently limited to 25% of regular capacity and timed entries are staggered.
- Guests ages 5 and older and staff are required to wear face coverings.
- Social distancing reminder signs help decrease crowding.
- We continue to implement enhanced cleaning protocols and have placed additional hand sanitizing stations throughout the exhibit.

Q. What is *Dinosaurs Revealed*?

A. *Dinosaurs Revealed* is a new exhibit that showcases dinosaurs from world-famous geologic dig sites across what is now North America. The dinosaurs shown lived in the Mesozoic Era (about 250 million to 66 million years ago), which includes the Triassic, Jurassic, and Cretaceous Periods. One of the key learning points of the exhibit is how the earth's geography, environment, and the climate changed through these geologic periods. Guests will see how and why dinosaurs—as well as other animals and plants—adapted, changed, and evolved as a result of the world in which they lived.

Q. Are there real fossils in the exhibit?

A. Yes, *Dinosaurs Revealed* showcases dozens of real fossils, plus two full dinosaur skeletons, and 26 animatronic dinosaurs that depict how scientists believe these creatures looked and sounded when they were alive.

Q. What can I expect when I visit *Dinosaurs Revealed*?

A. All of our visitors and staff are required to wear a face covering, and we ask everyone to maintain appropriate distance from each other during their visit (learn more about your museum visit on [our website](#)).

If you have already purchased tickets online, please check in at the OMSI front desk. Our guest services staff will direct you to the exhibit where you will enter a theater space to view a three-minute video that introduces the exhibit. Once inside, visitors can explore the two-floor exhibit freely.

Q. What is the recommended age limit for kids?

A. This exhibit is appropriate for audiences of all ages, including younger guests. There are 26 animatronic, life-like and life-size dinosaurs that move and emit sound. However, we recognize that every family is different and individual children are at varying stages of development. We recommend that you become familiar with and discuss the exhibition with any accompanying children before deciding whether or not to share this immersive experience with them.
