- Implement new activities and demonstrations with guests, ranging from arts and crafts to physics and engineering, depending on the needs of the event
- Assist with set-up and clean-up procedures for activities and demonstrations.
- Interact with visitors to help them explore and learn from OMSI demonstrations, exhibits and lab activities.
- Assist in maintaining a safe and secure environment for visitors and staff.
- Give clear directions and provide information about activities happening throughout the museum.
- Assist Public Programs Coordinator with research and development of educational demonstrations as needed.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS:

- Strong communication and customer service skills.
- Skillful in facilitating hands-on interactions and translating scientific information accurately and age-appropriately.
- Able to maintain a calm, pleasant, and cheerful demeanor in a noisy and crowded environment.
- Able to listen and communicate effectively with people of diverse backgrounds and ages.
- Dependable and punctual.
- Self-directed and willing to take initiative.
- Willing to follow OMSI rules and procedures.

SCHEDULE AND SUPPORT:

- OMSI After Dark events are typically on the last Wednesday from 5:30pm to 10:00 pm each month, but days may vary depending on the topic.
- Due to the training involved, volunteers should plan to be at a minimum of 4-6 events over the course of 1 year.
