- Facilitate admittance into the planetarium utilizing timed tickets to allow limited seating inside.
- When necessary, encourage parties to adhere to OMSI's safety protocols, including social distancing and wearing protective face coverings.
- During the show, monitor the audience for any safety concerns and escort guests out if they need to leave early.
- Assist the Space Science Educator as needed prior to, during, and after the show.

- Strong communication and customer service skills.
- Comfortable speaking to a large group with the use of a microphone.
- Able to listen to and communicate with people of diverse backgrounds, education levels, and ages.
