Biomimicry engages us with nature's strategies to design solutions for the challenges we face in our own communities around the world.

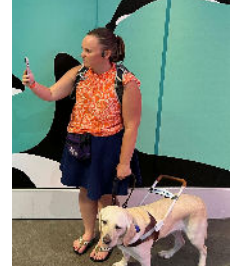

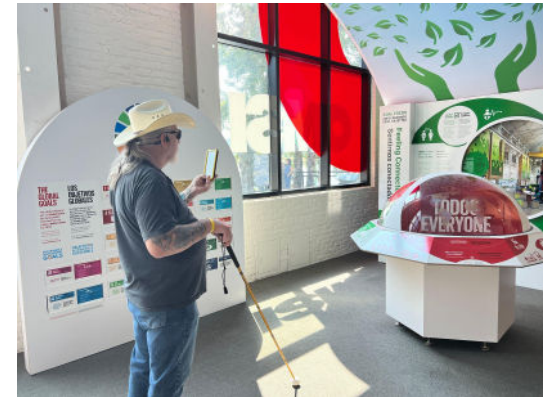
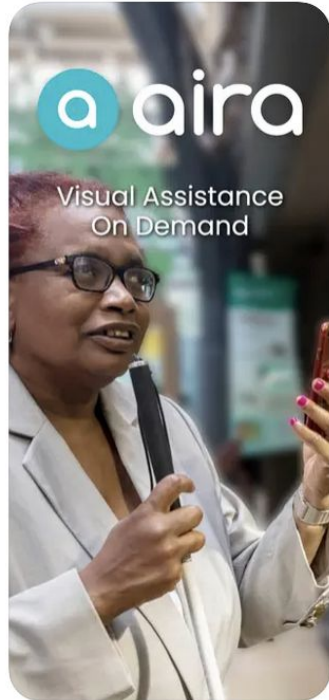
