The OMSI District

Located in the heart of Portland on the Willamette River, OMSI is well-suited to anchor the further development of a thriving urban community. The OMSI District – a collaboration of local, Tribal and regional government entities, nonprofits and businesses – will be a one-of-a-kind vibrant, inclusive neighborhood and community destination with innovation, culture, arts, and science learning at its heart. Covering 10 city blocks, the OMSI District will include 3M square feet of new transit-oriented development and 1,200 units of new housing, including affordable units. It will enable OMSI to further expand science programming in the city, state, and region and is projected to generate 11,000+ new jobs and \$1.2 billion in total economic output.
