As a Teen Tech Center Digital Media Project Mentor, you'll support youth as they dive into self-directed projects using tools like video editing software, graphic design platforms, music production gear, and more. This is a unique opportunity to empower young creators, encourage exploration, and help teens build confidence in a welcoming, inclusive, STEAM rich environment. This position is ideal for creative individuals who enjoy working with teens, are comfortable with digital tools, and want to make a meaningful impact through mentorship and project-based learning.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Encourage Exploration & Creativity: Support teens as they explore, collaborate, innovate, and create personal digital media projects using tools like video editing, music production, graphic design, 3-D printing, and more
- Mentor Through Co-Learning: Guide youth by asking open-ended questions, co-investigating ideas, and using facilitation techniques that promote curiosity and self-directed learning—rather than lecture-style instruction
- Support Project Development: Provide guidance and encouragement during the inspiration, planning, and creation phases of youth-led digital media projects
- Support Skill Development: Provide guidance and encouragement during structured workshops and unstructured drop-in period
- Maintain a Positive Environment: Help ensure the Teen Tech Center remains a safe, inclusive, and welcoming space for all participants; assist with class and program activities
