Position Summary: Visitors to the OMSI Chemistry Lab wear goggles and perform hands-on, wet chemistry experiments, view activities, and observe chemistry demonstrations. Volunteers who are comfortable with a rotating content schedule will enjoy this position!

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Interact with visitors to help them explore and engage with Chemistry Lab experiments and activities
- Prepare and maintain laboratory experiments, including the appearance and functionality of experiment stations
- Present various chemistry demonstrations, depending on comfort level, to a diverse audience of backgrounds and ages [Activity examples include Rocket Launch, Elephant Toothpaste, and Sugar Flares]
- Assist with other duties as assigned by Chemistry Lab Educators

Working Conditions

- Physical Demands: 70% sitting, 25% standing, 5% lifting/carrying 5-20 lbs;
 - Ability to push or pull carts and other equipment up to 5-20 lbs;
 - Requires some crouching, bending, or stooping;
 - Requires some climbing, crawling, kneeling, and twisting.
- Vision Demands include:
 - Close vision (clear vision at 20 inches or less)
 - Distance vision (clear vision at 20 feet or more)
- Environmental Demands include:
 - Regular and consistent public interaction
- Noise Levels include:
 - Moderate (examples: indoor playground, light traffic)
